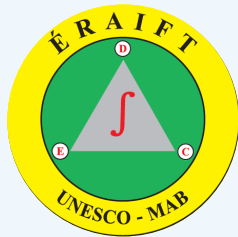


**Baudouin Michel**

Since 2010, Baudouin Michel has been the Director of the Regional Postgraduate School for the Integrated Planning and Management of Tropical Forests and Territories (ERAIFT), a Category 2 Center under the auspices of UNESCO.

As an agroecology engineer, he has been lecturing at Gembloux Agro-Bio Tech/ University of Liège (Belgium) since 1992.

Lastly, since 2017, he is a Special Envoy of the African Parks Network (RSA), a world leader in the management of natural reserves.



Since 1999, students from 22 African countries have enrolled at ERAIFT in the pursuit of a Masters or a PhD.

ERAIFT is funded by the DRC, UNESCO, the European Union, USAID, Belgium, Germany, FAO, Japan, and other partners.

Among its technical partners : University Paris Est (France), University of Liège (Belgium), University of Laval (Canada).
